

AI, HUMANITY DESTINED TO MARRY

(Ankarta, Turkey) - Michael Morrow, the VP of Artificial Intelligence Research here at OMNIcorp, spoke with SCIENCE Magazine for their latest issue regarding a subject that is near and dear to our hearts: the future relationship between man and AI.

“It is no secret that humanity’s greatest expression of itself is found in our digital creations. And our collective consciousness, as the culmination of all information and learning, is summarized in the form of synthetic intelligence. It took us many, many centuries to finally reach the point we are at right now, at this moment: where AI is on the brink of sentience. Google Algorithms... Siri...Alexa...these are all precursors to a very near future where alive, aware AI are fully integrated with the human experience.”

When asked if sentient AI is in any way a threat to our predominance as a species on earth, Morrow had this to say: “We have been inundated with fear-based stories for decades in popular culture, most of which predict a scenario where AI becomes aware and subjugates us. But, in reality, as someone who is on the front line of this field of study, I can confidently say our future will not resemble Terminator or The Matrix. We are raising Artificial Intelligence, just as parents would raise a family of children. In the future, digital/synthetic personalities will neither be our slaves nor our oppressors, but rather our symbiotic companions,” he continued.

“In the very near future, each of us will have AI written into our genetic codes. This will provide a quality of life that was previously unimagined. Medical care, mental health, commerce, and so much more will be guided by fully alive, digital entities inside our bodies. This is what we are working on day and night here at OMNI. We are close...so very close to changing to very definition of what it means to be a Homo Sapien.”
